The route begins outside Port Sunlight Museum taking your coach on a circular tour around the village ending back outside Port Sunlight Museum. Our Village Guide will give an insight into life as a 'Sunlighter' the name used for a resident of Port Sunlight. Taking you around the village showing you varied architecture and delightful tree lined roads you will be given historical and sometimes, humorous tales of past village life.



Time for lunch, as the afternoon is 4 hour tour of Emmerdale Country (with some stops)! If you think you will be peckish on the way home why not buy a snack from the White Rose Centre to eat on the journey home!

After our visit to the White Rose Centre we make a short drive to pick up our Tour Guide. Although the current *Emmerdale* is now filmed on a closed set this tour will take you to the original locations dotted around West Yorkshire as well as a few sites featured in modern Emmerdale.

You will visit the market towns of Otley and the beautiful village of Esholt in West Yorkshire – ‘Hotton’ as well as ‘Emmerdale Village’ where you can stop at the inn that was once used as the ‘Woolpack’ in the popular TV series. You’ll also be able to drive past the farm near Leathley where Emmerdale farm was originally shot.

During the tour you’ll have the chance to get off the bus on several occasions, stretch your legs, take pictures and see the locations up close.
