Attractions include the award-winning **Beatles Story**, which tells the story of four of the city's most famous residents who shook music and the world forever. Pair this leap into musical history with a trip on the **Magical Mystery Tour** that'll take you to Strawberry Fields and Penny Lane. **Tate Liverpool** is the home of art and culture at Albert Dock, past collections have included Andy Warhol and Jackson Pollock, it's anyone's guess who's next. Don't forget the **Merseyside Maritime Museum**, where you can explore Liverpool's maritime heritage and take some time to learn about Liverpool's history of slave trade at the **International Slavery Museum**

The newest attraction to Albert Dock is **Mattel Play! Liverpool** where you child's creativity and natural curiosity will bring their favourite characters and stories to life!
